1. **RULES**

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing for 2017-2020, the 2013 OBCA Standard Event Rules (Attachment 4) and the OBCA's Class Rules (Attachment 5) where applicable.
- 1.2 The YA Special Regulations Part 2 (for off the beach boats) shall apply.
- 1.3 RRS Appendix P (as amended by Standard event rule 6.10) will apply.

2. **ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 2.1 The regatta is open to Laser 4.7, Laser Radial, Open Bic, Optimist and Sabot.
- 2.2 All competitors must sign on in their respective class each day of the event. Sign on sheets will be available from the sailing office.

3. **FEES**

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4. SCHEDULE

Fri. 28th:	12. 00 hrs to 17.00 hrs	Boat drop off Registration / individual practice
Sat. 29th	09:00 hr 10:00 hr	Briefing Sailing Day 1. 2 races before lunch. After lunch break 2 more races
Sun. 30th	09:00 hr 10.00 hr	Briefing. Sailing Day 2 . 2 races before lunch. After lunch break 1 more race. Presentation of trophies and prizes will be held as soon as practicable after racing has finished.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available from Paradise Point Sailing Club

6. VENUE

6.1 Attachment 1: Attachment shows race area, highlighted in green, and club house situated at Paradise Point.

7. THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be outlined at the morning briefing on each day of the regatta

8. PENALTY SYSTEM and EVENT JUDGING

The Penalty system and event Judging will be in accordance with the 2017-2020 blue book

9. SCORING

- 9.1 The scoring will be in accordance with Standard event rule A4 (Low point scoring system).
- 9.2 A minimum of four (4) races to be completed over the two days for it to be classed as a regatta
- 9.3 **one race drop will be allowed if a minimum of 5 races are completed**



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10. SUPPORT BOATS

Support and coach boats shall keep clear and 50 metres outside the course area and to leeward of all competitors when racing. The course area is defined as the area a boat is likely to sail in.

11. AUDIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

12. PRIZES

Prizes will be given as outlined in the Sailing Instructions

13. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

14. INSURANCE

- 14.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$AU10 000 000.00 per event or the equivalent.
- 14.2 Competitors maybe required to produce evidence of such insurance and any competitor not holding this cover shall withdraw their entry.
- 14.3 Third Party and Boat insurance can be purchased from relevant insurance companies

15. RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

In participating, a competitor automatically grants to the Organising Authorities, the Coordinating Authorities and the sponsors, the right in perpetuity, to make, use and show, from time to time and at their discretion, any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of him/her during the period of the competition in which the competitor participates and in all material related to the said Event without compensation.

16. AMENDMENTS

Any amendments to this Notice of Race will be posted on the club notice board and available on the clubs website
